Project Overview

Prime contractor for large-scale ecosystem restoration project, which includes the following:

- Excavation and disposal off-site of approximately 5,825 cubic yards of contaminated soil from the river channel,
- Excavation and disposal off-site of approximately 3,265 cubic yards of organic earth material,
- Excavation, moving and re-grading of clean soil at the project site,
- Control and diversion of water to perform demolition and construction in dry conditions,
- Utility relocation,
- Demolition and removal of an approximately 140 foot long and 10 foot high concrete dam,
- Demolition and removal of approximately of 2,200 linear feet of concrete retaining walls,
- Extensive tree removal
- Construction of new river channel and riffle pools,
- Removal of undesirable vegetation (phragmites),
- Hydroseeding, and
- Extensive plantings including shrubs and trees.



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
